BHUTAN TOUR

DAY 01: ARRIVE PARO (BHUTAN) BY FLIGHT & TRANSFER TO THIMPHU (55 KMS)

Arrive at Paro airport. Meet and greet with Warm Welcome! and transfer Thimphu. Upon arrival check-in at hotel. Afterwards an exploratory walk around Thimphu main street and market area. Overnight at the hotel in Thimphu. (Altitude 2320m)

DAY 02: THIMPHU

Morning after breakfast take a short drive to Pangri Zampa, the 16th century monastery. Then proceed for a tour of some of city's main highlights: Textile Museum, National Library, Institute for Zorig Chusum: Commonly known as Arts & Crafts School or Painting School & Folk Heritage Museum. Lunch is followed by a city tour that includes: Memorial Chorten, Changangkha Lhakhang. Overnight at the hotel in Thimphu.

DAY 03: THIMPHU – PUNAKHA (75 KM)

Morning after breakfast drive up to Dochu-la pass (3,088m/ 10,130 ft) stopping briefly here to take in the view and admire the chorten, mani wall, and prayer flags which decorate the highest point on the road. Then explore some part of Royal Botanical Park: It is the first botanical park in Bhutan and forms the backdrop of the Dochula Pass. Later drive onward to Punakha. Upon arrival check-in at hotel. After lunch, visit Punakha Dzong or (Palace of Great Happiness), built at the junction of the Phochu and Mochu rivers in 1637 by Shabdrung Ngawang Namgyal. Then a short excursion to Chimi Lhakhang. Evening explore newly developed Wangdue town and its local market. Overnight at the hotel in Punakha. (Altitude 1,300m)

DAY 04: PUNAKHA

Morning after breakfast visit Sangchhen Dorji Lhuendrup Lhakhang Nunnery. Thereafter, a beautiful hike takes one to the regal Khamsum Yuelley Namgel Chorten, which was built to remove negative forces and promote peace, stability and harmony in the changing world. Post lunch, excursion to Talo village, which is scattered along the hill slopes and known for its cleanliness and hygiene among Punakha villages. Also visit Nalanda Buddhist Institute. Locals call this place 'Dalayna' and the monks call it Nalanda Buddhist College. Overnight at the hotel in Punakha.

DAY 05: PUNAKHA – PARO (125 KMS)

Morning after breakfast drive to Paro. En route visit Simtokha Dzong, the oldest fortress of the country built in 1627 which now houses the School for Buddhist studies. Upon arrival check-in at hotel. Post lunch, proceed to visit Ta Dzong, originally built as Watchtower, which now houses National Museum. Ta Dzong visit immediately followed by a short walk down the trail to visit Rinpung Dzong (Paro Dzong). Evening explore Paro city centre and market area. Overnight at the hotel in Paro. (Altitude 2,280m)

DAY 06: PARO

Morning after breakfast embark on a fascinating excursion to Taktshang Monastery or Tiger's Nest. Late afternoon drive end of the Valley to the base of Drukgyel Dzong, a 17th century fortress burned down in the early 50s. Here we will also see the beautiful typical farmhouse. Overnight at the hotel in Paro.

DAY 07: DEPART PARO BY FLIGHT

Morning after breakfast at the hotel drive to the airport for the flight to your onward destination.
