WINE TOUR IN INDIA

DAY 01: ARRIVE DELHI

Arrive at Delhi's airport, meet and greet upon arrival with Warm Welcome garlanding with fresh marigold flowers and transfer to hotel for check in. (Check in time at hotel is 12 noon). Stay Overnight at the hotel.

DAY 02: DELHI

Morning after breakfast proceed for tour of Old Delhi commences with a visit drive pass Red Fort Continue to the Jama Masjid, largest mosque built from 1644-1658, during the reign of Emperor Shahjahan. You will end your morning tour on a cycle rickshaw through the famous Chandni Chowk Bazaars. Later visit Mahatma Gandhi's Memorial at Raj Ghat, where the Father of the Nation was cremated.

This afternoon's tour of New Delhi starts at the Qutab Minar. You will drive past India Gate, dedicated to the nation 10 years later by the then Viceroy, Lord Irwin. Another memorial, Amar Jawan Jyoti was added much later, after India's independence and ending the day's tour with a drive past of the Houses of Parliament and Presidential Palace, both grandiose masterpieces of the British Raj. Stay overnight at the hotel.

DAY 03: DELHI – AGRA (210 KMS)

Morning after breakfast drive to Agra. Upon arrival Agra check in at hotel. Afternoon proceed for tour of Agra fort - Agra Fort built by Emperor Akbar over the years 1565 – 1573 with its maze of courtyards, mosques, and private chambers.

Later visit Taj Mahal, built by the Mughal Emperor Shah Jahan, this beautiful mausoleum is built of pure white marble and is an architectural marvel. Built in the memory of his beloved queen Mumtaz Mahal. The building was conceived as a garden tomb with the mausoleum rising at the far end of the complex with the river Yamuna flowing below. Beneath the dome are the cenotaphs of Mumtaz Mahal and Shah Jahan.. Stay overnight at the hotel.

DAY 04: AGRA – ABHANERI – JAIPUR (245 KMS)

Morning after breakfast drive to Jaipur En route visit Chand Baori is a stepwell situated in the village of Abhaneri. After the tour of Abhaneri continue your drive to Jaipur. Upon arrival Jaipur check in at Hotel. Evening enjoy dinner with a local family in Jaipur. Learn about local life in Jaipur and also see how some typical Rajasthani dishes are prepared. Stay overnight at hotel.

DAY 05: JAIPUR

Morning after breakfast proceed for excursion of Amber Fort, Enroute photo stop at Hawa Mahal - the Palace of winds.

Afternoon city tour begins with a visit to the Maharaja's City Palace, the former Royal residence, part of it converted into a museum. Later visit the Jantar Mantar, which is the largest stone and marble crafted observatory in the world. Stay overnight at the hotel.

DAY 06: JAIPUR - UDAIPUR (400 KMS)

Morning after breakfast drive to Udaipur. Upon arrival check-in at the hotel. Stay overnight at the hotel.

DAY 07: UDAIPUR

Morning after breakfast sightseeing tour of Udaipur city. Among the places visited are the City Palace – a majestic architectural marvel towering over the lake.

Later visit the Bharatiya Lok Kala Mandal, which houses an interesting collection of folk dresses, ornaments, puppets, masks, dolls, folk musical instruments, paintings etc; the Sahelyon ki Bari with its many fountains.

Afternoon: A highlight of your trip to Udaipur is a sunset boat cruise on the beautiful placid Lake Pichola. Stay overnight at the hotel.

DAY 08: UDAIPUR – MUMBAI (FLIGHT) & MUMBAI – NASHIK (170 KMS)

Morning after breakfast transfer to airport to board flight to Mumbai (0650 – 0810 Hrs). Meet upon arrival at airport and drive to Nashik 170 Kms, approx 03 hrs drive. Situated at 2,000 feet above sea level, Nashik is India's leading grape-growing region. On arrival at Nashik, check-in to the Sula Vineyards & relax. Stay overnight at the hotel.

DAY 09: NASHIK (SULA VINEYARD)

Morning after breakfast drive to Sula Vineyards. Sula is known as India's most trendy and most handy winery. From modest beginnings in the year 1997, Sula has excellently developed into a world class winery. Sula Vineyards is located to the west of Nashik, close to Gangapur Dam. Return back to Nashik for an overnight stay.

DAY 10: NASHIK

Morning after breakfast visit Soma Vineyard is a newer and lesser-known winery that has quickly embraced wine tourism. Return back to Sula Vineyard for an overnight stay.

DAY 11: NASHIK – MUMBAI (170 KMS)

Morning after breakfast drive back to Mumbai. Enroute visit Vallonne Vineyards with lunch was set up in 2009 and is a boutique producer of India's first premium French-style wines, using state-of-the-art technology from France.

Later drive to Mumbai. Upon arrival check-in at the hotel. Stay overnight at the hotel.

DAY 12: MUMBAI

In time transfer to Cochin airport to board the flight for onward destination. Morning after breakfast proceed for half day city tour of Mumbai - visit Gateway of India. Followed by a drive through Hanging Gardens. Continue to the Dhobi Ghat, an open-air laundry where washmen physically clean and iron hundreds of items of clothing, delivering them the next day. Next, visit Chhatrapati Shivaji Terminus (known as Victoria Terminus). The half day at leisure or free for shopping. Stay overnight at the hotel.

DAY 13: DEPART – MUMBAI

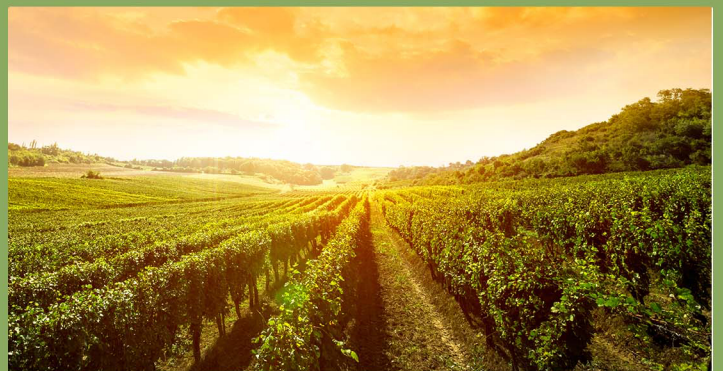
In time Transfer to Mumbai airport to board your flight for onward destination.
